

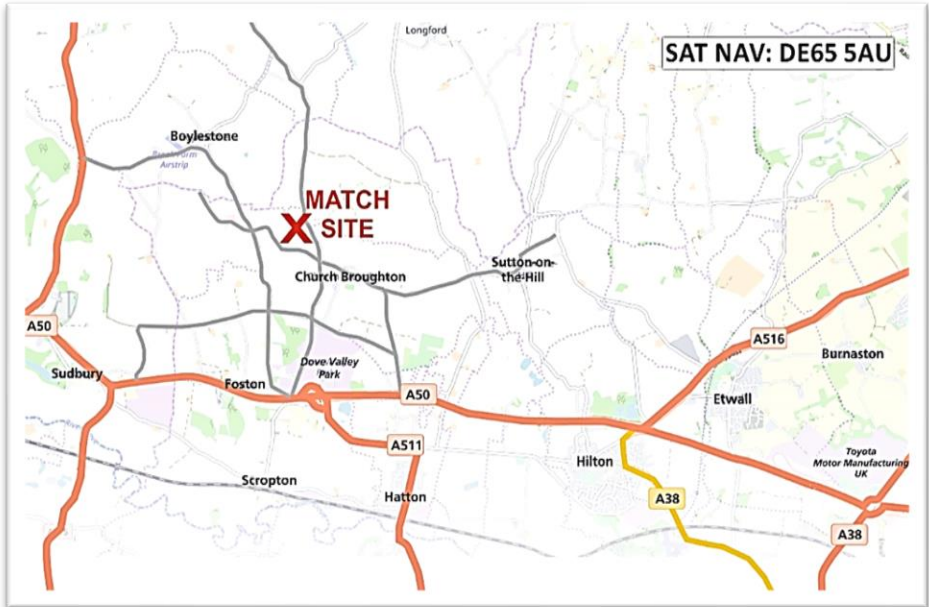

**WHEN SENDING YOUR ENTRY FORM PLEASE SEND A STAMPED  
ADDRESSED ENVELOPE.**

You will receive a car pass to gain entry onto the ground to be able to unload your entries near the Ladies' Tent. After unloading you will have to move your car to the official car park. This will not be an admission ticket to the ploughing match.

3. All entries to be staged by 10.30am prompt.
4. Entries may not be removed until after the raffle is drawn.
5. Prize Money:-  
1<sup>st</sup> £3.50; 2<sup>nd</sup> £3.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> £2.50; 4<sup>th</sup> £2.00.  
4<sup>th</sup> prize is only awarded in classes with 6 or more exhibits.

**ALL PRIZE MONEY TO BE COLLECTED AFTER 3.30PM**  
**IN THE LADIES' TENT**

**Any prize money not collected on the day will be given to charity.**

6. No entrant shall receive more than one prize in any one class.
7. ALL classes open to men.
8. All entries to be made or grown by the exhibitor.
9. All exhibits may be covered with cellophane after judging.
10. Any objections must be made within 30 minutes of the completion of judging.

12. In the event of a tie for a trophy in any of the sections, the number of first prizes will be taken into consideration.

### NOTES CONCERNING HOME PRESERVES

**Lemon Curd** – Must have cellophane and wax disc.

**Jam** – Preferable to have wax disc and cellophane. New screw tops acceptable.

**Chutney** – Screw plastic lid with plastic coating – new screw tops must be put on whilst preserve is HOT. Should be made at least 6 months prior to exhibiting.

- Class 4. **Jar of lemon curd**, dated
- Class 5. **Jar of fruit jelly**, dated
- Class 6. **Jar of soft fruit jam**, dated
- Class 7. **Jar of stone fruit jam**, dated
- Class 8. **Jar of marmalade**, dated
- Class 9. **Jar of chutney**
- Class 10. **Small bottle of fruit flavoured gin**
- Class 11. **Four cheese scones**
- Class 12. **Savoury quiche**
- Class 13. **Four sausage rolls**
- Class 14. **Date and walnut loaf to the following recipe -**

8oz dates	A pinch of bicarbonate of soda
¼ pint boiling water	3oz margarine
3oz caster sugar	1 medium egg, beaten
8oz S.R. flour	3oz walnuts, chopped

Heat oven to 180C, gas mark 4. Grease and line a 2lb loaf tin.

Chop the dates, add the b of soda and pour the boiling water over them. Cream the marg and sugar, beat in the egg. Stir in the flour and nuts and lastly the dates. Place mixture into tin and bake for about 1¼ hours until firm.

- Class 15. **Round of shortbread**

- Class 16. **Four chocolate macaroons to the following recipe –**

*Makes 16 (approx), bake 8-10 minutes, 180C/fan 160, gas mark 4*

2½oz ground almonds	4½oz icing sugar
½oz cocoa	2 egg whites

Filling

¼ pint double cream	1 tsp icing sugar
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½ tsp vanilla essence	Melt white chocolate to decorate
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Line a baking sheet with non-stick baking paper. Blitz almonds, icing sugar and cocoa in a food processor until very fine. Whisk egg whites until stiff and fold in cocoa mixture. Spoon into piping bag and pipe 2 inch circles well spread on to a baking sheet. Leave to stand for 15 minutes then bake for about 8-10 minutes until beginning to firm. Leave to cool. Whip cream, icing sugar, vanilla essence together until peaks form. Sandwich the macaroons together. Melt white chocolate and drizzle over macaroons to decorate.

Class 17. **Gluten free cake or four cakes – please give recipe**

Class 18. **Individual Bakewell tarts**

Class 19. **Boiled fruit cake to the following recipe –**

4oz margarine	6oz caster sugar
6oz currants	6oz sultanas
2tbsp marmalade	8oz water
1 level tsp bicarbonate of soda	

Place margarine, sugar, marmalade, currants, sultanas, bicarb and water in a pan (no lid) and simmer for 5 minutes. Allow to cool, then add 2 beaten eggs, 4oz plain flour and 4oz self raising flour. Mix well, then put in 9inch round tin (approx.) or 2lb loaf tin and bake at 160C for approx. 1½ - 2 hours.

Class 20. **Victoria sponge – 3 egg size**

Class 21. **Ginger creams to the following recipe –**

50g margarine	25ml golden syrup
175g S R flour	50g demerara sugar
50g light muscovado sugar	½ tsp bicarbonate of soda
Small egg	7g ground ginger
Filling	

100g butter	200g icing sugar
7g ground ginger	Splash of milk

Oven 170C. Put the margarine and golden syrup in a bowl and microwave till melted. Add all the dry ingredients in a bowl and add the melted syrup, margarine and egg mix until combined into a sticky dough. Roll in balls about 30g and flatten slightly. Place on a baking tray and bake for about 18 minutes and allow to cool. Mix all the filling ingredients together until smooth. Pipe the buttercream onto the bottom half of the biscuits and then sandwich the other biscuit onto these.
